The producer I've selected for this month's featured wine is the **Arrels** Garnatxa from Spain, and it is a true gem. It comes from a region called Monstant that hugs Priorat and has similar black slate soils mixed with a little bit of clay. The clay offers the vines a bit of finesse to round off the boldness of a typical Priorat. Created by the first ever Spanish Master Sommelier, **Emmanuel Kemiji**, there are only 385 cases produced and half of it had to stay in Spain. It is full of dried plum, blackberry and mashed raspberries on the nose that mismatches the black olive and salted walnuts on the palate. Expect an intense acidity and somewhat savory finish (I think of the inside of a beef jerky bag) to cap off the experience.
